Details

Alison Pakes is known to all Councillors as a tenacious and passionate advocate for the retention of library services at Milton Library. Alison lead community opposition to any reduction in services and the concern that Council wanted to close the library and lease the premises for other purposes.

Part of the success of Alison's campaign was and remains the establishment of the Friends of Milton Library. With 30 active volunteers and a thriving book club community of 250 who have over 120 sets of book club books, it has indeed been an intense five years for Alison.
