Mr Ryan Schulter advised that staff have sent correspondence to Motorcycling NSW regarding their intentions for the Motorplex site and the future, to date no response has been received.

Representatives from the Nowra District Motorcycle Club addressed the meeting provided background on the Club. A summary of the information is provided:

- The Nowra District Motorcycle Club was under the control of Motorcycling NSW
- The Club is back under local control and they have held their first Committee meeting and have developed a Constitution.
- The permissive occupancy will remain in the name of the Nowra District Motorcycle Club

It was noted that Nowra District Motorcycling Club is being governed locally, including the Permissive Occupancy of the site. Discussions with Motorcycling NSW have revealed they are not interested in any further development and the site is no longer under their control. It was also noted that in relation to the 5-year clause, it was done so that if the club folded, the Permissive Occupancy would not be lost, and Motorcycle NSW has indicated its support for the Club to continue to operate into the future.
